The objects described on the face of this agreement are subject to the following conditions:

**Care and Preservation:** The Hall of Fame & Museum will give objects left in its custody the same care provided similar property of its own. Evidence of damage to the objects at the time of receipt or while in the Hall of Fame & Museum custody will be reported to the lender. No alterations, restoration or repair to objects will be undertaken without written authorization of the lender. The lender certifies that the objects lent are in good condition and will withstand ordinary strains of packing and transportation. Due to the fragile nature of works of art, the Hall of Fame & Museum reserves the right to remove objects from exhibition to provide a period of rest for said objects.

**Insurance:** The Hall of Fame & Museum will insure the object under its fine-arts policy for the amount specified by the lender on the reverse side of this agreement for its fair market value or replacement value, whichever is less, against all risks of physical loss or damage while in transit to and from Hall of Fame & Museum's location, and on location at the Hall of Fame & Museum's facility during the period of the loan. If no amount has been specified by the lender, Hall of Fame & Museum will insure the object at its own estimated market value, which lender accepts as the reasonable amount of insurance to cover possible loss or damage.

The Hall of Fame & Museum's fine-arts policy contains the usual exclusions for loss or damage due to such causes as war, invasion, hostilities, insurrection, confiscation by order of any government or public authority, risks of contraband or illegal transportation and/or trade, nuclear damage, gradual deterioration and inherent vice or vermin. THE LENDER AGREES THAT IN THE EVENT OF LOSS OR DAMAGE, RECOVERY FROM AMERICAN QUARTER HORSE HALL OF FAME & MUSEUM WILL BE LIMITED TO THE AMOUNT, IF ANY, PAID BY THE INSURER ONLY, HEREBY AGREEING THAT AMERICAN QUARTER

HORSE HALL OF FAME & MUSEUM HAS FULLY MET IT'S LEGAL RESPONSIBILITY BY PROVIDING THE INSURANCE COVERAGE SPECIFIED HEREIN, WHETHER OR NOT THE LOSS OR DAMAGE WAS CAUSED BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE HALL OF FAME & MUSEUM, ITS TRUSTEES, OFFICERS, AGENTS OR EMPLOYEES. A certificate of insurance will be sent to the lender upon request.

By the below provisions, lender elects to provide its own insurance covering the perils above described. If the lender chooses to maintain its own insurance, Hall of Fame & Museum shall be supplied with a certificate of insurance naming Hall of Fame & Museum as additional insured, and having provision for thirty (30) days prior written notice to Hall of Fame & Museum of cancellation or amendment. If the lender fails to supply Hall of Fame & Museum with such a certificate within thirty (30) days of Hall of Fame & Museum assuming possession of the object, or if the lender fails to provide insurance, in either event, Hall of Fame & Museum is hereby released and discharged from any liability in connection with the object. Lender bears responsibility for any error or deficiency in information furnished to the lender's insurer or for any lapses or amendment in coverage.

The undersigned verifies that the following object(s) loaned to the American Quarter Horse Hall of Fame & Museum, left their custody in good condition unless otherwise specified. The undersigned understands that this is a loan to the American Quarter Horse Hall of Fame & Museum for the period of six months.
